## WHY OUR WORK MATTERS

Increasing access to education and employment for people with disabilities is not just the right thing to do—it's an economic imperative. Data shows that individuals with disabilities who attain a bachelor's degree are three times more likely to be employed, earn significantly higher wages, and contribute to the tax base rather than relying on public benefits. Nationally, closing the education-employment gap for people with disabilities could unlock tens of billions in GDP growth, reduce government spending on benefits by billions, and fill critical workforce shortages in industries like healthcare, technology, and education.

By investing in educational and employment programs that empower people with disabilities, we are not only transforming lives—we are fueling a stronger, more inclusive economy for all.

We believe the disability community's potential is limitless, far exceeding what has historically been realized. Much of this human potential has been locked up due to stigma and low expectations. If just 1% more people with disabilities joined the workforce, it would add \$25 billion to the U.S. GDP annually.

That's just 1%! Imagine what a 10% increase could do—potentially adding \$250 billion per year.

Closing the employment gap for working-age adults with disabilities would generate an estimated \$21 billion in additional federal tax revenue over a decade.

Our signature scholarship program has awarded 1,010 grants to college students with disabilities in OR, WA, & CA

- Over 300 dients have secured full time jobs and internships through INCIGHT events, coaching and support
- Since 2011, INCIGHT's 70+ Job Fair events have served 9,800 students and jobseekers with a variety of disabilities and barriers

- Since the creation of our Online learning platform in 2018, the INCIGHTFUL Curriculum has grown in users by 200% year over year on average
- Developed 88 curriculum lessons on the INCIGHTful Learning Platform designed for high school students with disabilities to build soft skills in their future pursuit of education, employment and independence
- Created 28 lessons specific for adult jobseekers with disabilities and developed 9 lessons in a pilot for employers looking to promote a more
  inclusive workspace
- Moda Health continuously honors INCIGHT with in-kind donations and programmatic support helping us to share a Positive Perspective about Disabilities



- Contracted to conduct workshops for 15 major
   employers on disability awareness in the workplace
- In the last 8 months local entities have invested over \$20,000 to promote inclusive workplace culture through INCIGHT training
